Bowling Promotion Tour 2023 - Mixed Doubles Rules & Regulations:

This year the tour will feature the mixed doubles event after being taken out of circulation after the 2021 tour. This will replace the Womens series to allow not only the top 4 women, but top 4 men also to compete together for the title of the Bowling Promotion Tour Mixed Doubles champions.

Mixed Doubles Qualification:

Based on the 18 Games of qualifying for the masters series the top 4 Male & Female competitors on scratch pinfall will formulate the teams and seeding for the mixed doubles tv show. The teams will be made up as followed.

#1 seed = #1 male & #1 female #2 seed = #2 male & #2 female #3 seed = #3 male & #3 female #4 seed = #4 male & #4 female

TV Finals rules & format

the players will decide between themselves as a team who they want to play in what order with the order being as follows:

Player 1 - frames 1, 3, 5, 7 & 9 Player 2 - frames 2, 4, 6, 8 & 10

Between matches the players are allowed to change the order if necessary but similar to the team series rules you are not allowed to change the order after the first ball of the match has been thrown.

The TV format will consist of 3 TV televised matches with the #3 & #4 seed playing in the 1/4 finals and then the winner will face the #2 seed in the semi final and the winner of this match will play the final against the #1 seed. the format below gives a visual representation of the finals stepladder format.

Tie Breaker Rules:

In the result of a tie in the mixed doubles the tie breaker will consist of both members of each doubles pairing. Each player will throw one ball receiving a pin count. the 2 players pin counts will then be added together (Max score 20) to determine the winner.

If the tie-break results in to another tie-break situation then each doubles team will decide for one bowler to play the single tie break taking 1 shot against the other selected member of the opposing team until 1 pinfall is higher than the other in a one ball roll-off.
